Definitions

Founded Suspicion - Suspicion that criminal activity is afoot, based on observable conduct or reliable hearsay information.
Reasonable Suspicion - Exists when the information known to an Officer would make an ordinarily prudent and cautious person under the circumstances believe that a Penal Law Felony or Misdemeanor has been, is being, or is about to be committed.
Noncustodial Questioning - The questioning of an individual during an investigation into criminal activity, where such individual has not been detained and is free to send the encounter at will **(Level 2)**
